ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

- This will be a week-long training programme for Second year undergraduate (B.Sc/Integrated M.Sc.) Mathematics students.
- The participants for the programme will primarily be students from West Bengal and the neighbouring states.
- The programme is funded by the National Board for Higher Mathematics and is organized under the aegis of MTTS Trust.
- There will be courses in Linear Algebra, Real Analysis, Number Theory and Foundations.
- Participants will be provided with food and study materials. Further, outstation participants will be provided with lodging and will be paid sleeper class train fare or equivalent bus fare.

ABOUT MTTS PROGRAMME

The Mathematics Training and Talent Search (MTTS) programme is one of the most popular and significant training programmes in India. This programme has been running since 1993 and has made an impressive impact on mathematical scenario in the country. The faculty consists of active mathematicians with a commitment to teaching and are from various leading institutions. The aim of the instructions is not to give routine lectures but to stimulate the participants to think and discover mathematical results.

Mini-MTTS programmes are shorter version of the main MTTS Pragramme. These are organized at regional level so as to provide opportunities to a larger number of students who do not get a chance to participate in main camps of the MTTS.
